

# CONTINUATION FLYING TRAINING AWARDS



## Information

The purpose of the awards is to provide continuation flying training to selected graduates of the Air Cadet Flying and Gliding Scholarship Program. All awards are of equal value - \$300.00.

Establishment of these awards has been made possible through the generosity of individual persons and organizations.

Candidates for an award must meet all of the following Conditions of Eligibility:

- (a) Must submit a request for this assistance, stating their need and future intentions;
- (b) Must have successfully completed an Air Cadet Flying or Gliding Scholarship Course;
- (c) Must hold a valid and current Transport Canada (TC) Private Pilot or Glider Pilot Licence;
- (d) Must have obtained a high rating in written and flying tests carried out in conjunction with the Flying/Gliding Scholarship Course;
- (e) Must be interested in pursuing a possible future career in the field of aviation or within the Air Cadet Flying program;
- (f) Must be actively enrolled in an Air Cadet Squadron;
- (g) Must be recommended by their Commanding Officer and Sponsoring Committee Chairperson; and,
- (h) Must have Parental or Guardian approval.

Nominations including supporting information should arrive at Air Cadet League Headquarters, 313 Rideau Street, Ottawa, Ontario K1N 5Y4, postmarked no later than October 1<sup>st</sup> in the year of application. Entries received after this date will not be eligible.

Final selection of the award winners will be made by the National Honours and Awards Committee of the Air Cadet League and the winners announced at the Semi-Annual Meeting of Governors and Committees in November. Decisions of the committee will be considered final. Winners will be notified by mail.
